### Accounts

- Calculator

- A3 display file to keep the drawings in after every lesson [image 3]

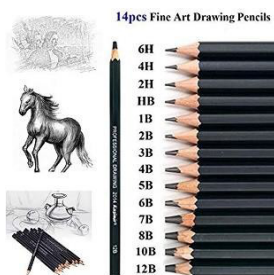

The following items can be bought after the first week of school. The teacher will show the following art material in class so that students will know exactly what is required to avoid misunderstandings while purchasing the items:

- Oil pastels (the best are neo-pastels – a box of minimum 12 [image 4])
- Chalk pastels (a box of minimum 12) [image 5]
- Aquarelle pencils (a box of minimum 25-30) [image 6]
- 2 black felt-tip pens or ball pens
- A pack of acrylic paints [image 7]

- A set of soft paint brushes consisting of both flat and round brushes. If brushes are bought individually, students need flat brushes sizes: 10, 12 and 16 and round brushes sizes: 4 and 6 or the nearest to these sizes [image 8]
- A plastic container for water
- An apron to protect the uniform
- A plastic palette [image 9]
- A cloth to rinse the brushes

  - Listening Comprehension and Role Play
